

Discipline Policy



Calvary Christian Academy uses demerit system as the basis for its disciplinary action and policy. **It is impossible to teach and learn in chaos.** Hence, it is imperative that CCA students abide by the school rules and regulations. **We expect all parents to support the schools discipline policy.** It is very important that students understand that the teacher is the authority figure in the classroom, as you are in your home. (Romans 13: 1-2) “Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. Therefore, whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.” (KJV).

It is impossible to list or categorize all types of disciplinary violations, thus the administration reserves the right of disciplinary assignments as the case so determines. Rules and regulations apply in school, on the subway, or buses, on the school property, and at any and all school sponsored activities.

The administration expects all CCA students to abide by the following:

The Demerit Point System functions as follows:

A total of 100 demerits or points can be accumulated during the entire school year. If a student reaches 100 demerits before the school year is over he or she will be expelled from CCA.

Assignment of Demerit points:

Students conduct demerit system.	
10 demerits	A letter is mailed to the parents.
20 demerits	A letter is mailed to the parents; mandatory parent meeting.
30 demerits	One day suspension, letter mailed to parents.
40 demerits	A letter is mailed to parents, two days of suspension.
50 demerits	A letter is mailed to parents, 3 days suspension, and is put on probation. Pre- expulsion hearing is conducted by discipline committee.
60 demerits	A letter is mailed to parents, five (5) day suspension, mandatory parent meeting with the Superintendent.
70 demerits	A letter is mailed to parents, ten (10) day suspension, pre-expulsion hearing conducted by discipline committee.
80 demerits	A letter is mailed to parents, fifteen (15) days suspension and recommendation for expulsion to the Superintendent.
90 demerits	A letter is mailed to parents, twenty (20) days suspension and recommendation to the Superintendent for expulsion.
100 demerits	A letter mailed to parents and the recommendation to the Superintendent for immediate expulsion.

The CCA staff will adhere to the following demerit/point system:

OFFENSE	DEMERIT
1. Out of uniform.	5-per infraction
2. Playing and talking excessively.	5-per infraction after one verbal warning
3. Displaying disruptive behavior during class, lunch and recess.	10-per infraction after one verbal warning
4. Disrespectful to Teacher/staff member	30-per infraction
5. Misconduct in CCA'S facility	20-per infraction
6. Inappropriate language	20-per infraction
7. Fighting/Biting	60-per infraction with possibility of expulsion
8. Cheating	60- per infraction with possibility of expulsion
9. Hitting a Teacher or Staff Member	80- per infraction with possibility of expulsion
10. Taunting/excessive teasing	50-per infraction
11. Leaving school grounds without permission	50-per infraction
